## Applicants Sought for MASCA Academic Scholarships

(Join MASCA to be eligible!!)

For several years, MASCA has awarded an academic scholarship to a person pursuing an academic degree beyond secondary education (undergraduate or graduate) in preparation for a career or for advancing a career in the justice system. For the second year, MASCA will be awarding two scholarships each worth \$1,000.

In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship, the applicant must be a current member of MASCA or the spouse or child of a MASCA member. Members of the MASCA Board of Trustees, their spouses, and children are not eligible for this award.

Applicants must be actively engaged in an academic course of study at an accredited college or university with an emphasis on juvenile or criminal justice and with the intent of pursuing a career in this area. Work experience in the justice system is not a requirement.

To be considered, an application form must be submitted with a postmark no later than May 1, 2008. A resume and a copy of the most recent transcript must be submitted along with the application. In addition,

the applicant must submit an essay no longer than two pages describing the applicant's career goals and what that individual would like to accomplish by working in the Juvenile/criminal justice system.
